



Bread consumption: Worksheet

1. How has bread consumption changed in London over time?

- Open the AQA Large data set spreadsheet. Use the tab for London.
- Draw a line graph to show the consumption of white bread, brown bread, other bread and all bread over time, and comment on what this tells you.

2. Comparing

- Compare the time series for London with similar time series for other regions.
- Compare the time series for the whole of England with the time series for one or more regions in England.

3. Considering modelling assumptions

- Look at the ways in which different types of bread have been grouped into the categories 'white bread', 'brown bread' and 'other bread'. Do you think this is a sensible way of categorising types of bread? How else might you do it?
- What possible reasons can you identify for the regional differences and differences over time?

4. Further work

- Investigate how consumption of butter and margarine has changed over time.
